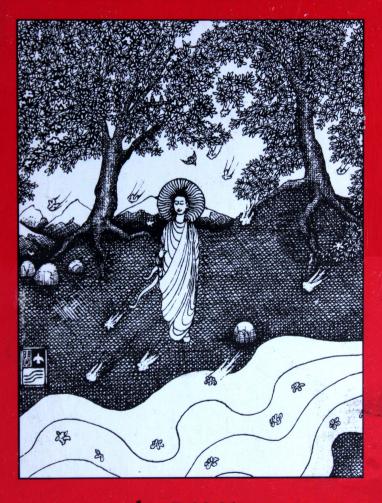
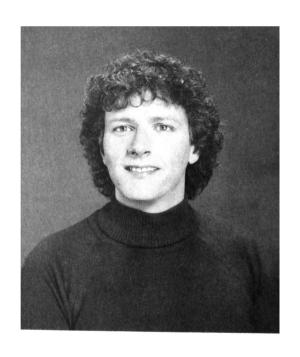

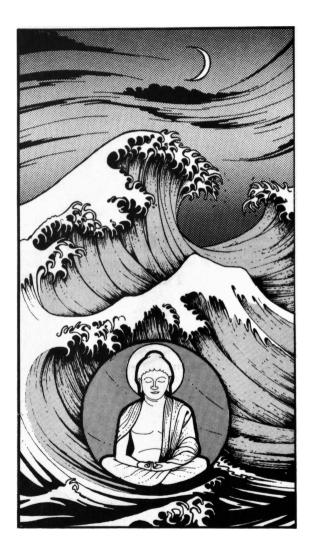

It flows in you and through you.

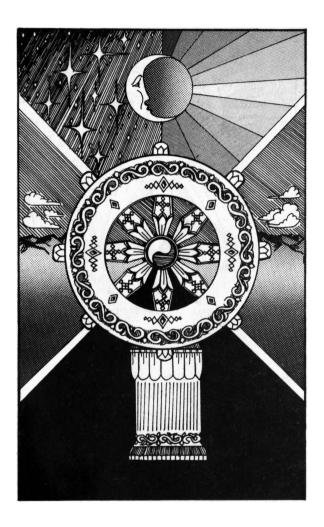
As you stand on the banks of the

The Truth that is Love.



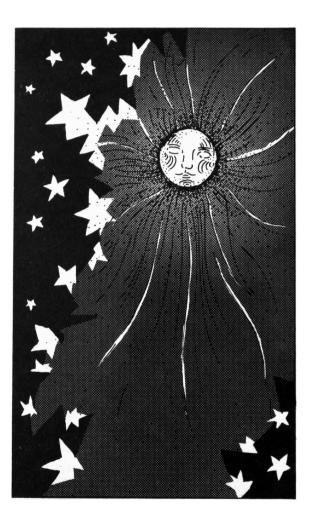

Only to dissolve in the light of the Noonday sun.

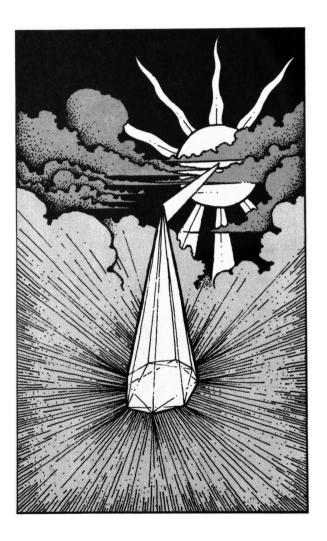


There is some Truth in everything.

And there is a much greater Truth from Which all of these lesser truths come forth.

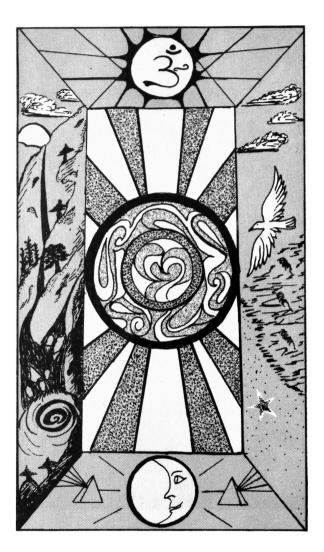
In this world we only see these Reflections of Truth.

Your mind is filled with thoughts and Impressions:

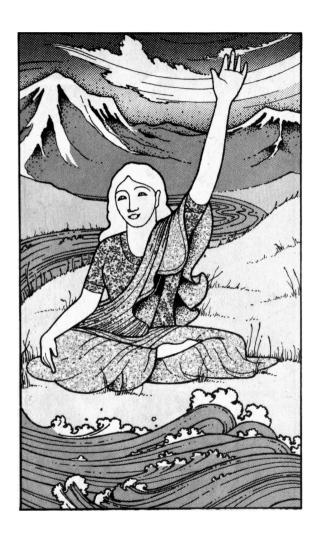
See life pass before your eyes.

River of Time.

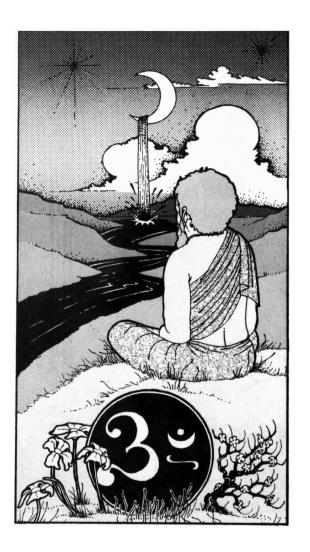
Life is a river; Sit on its banks and watch it go by, Observe how it pulls people to and fro.

Wave at them as they go by. Send them your love. Wish them well on their journey.



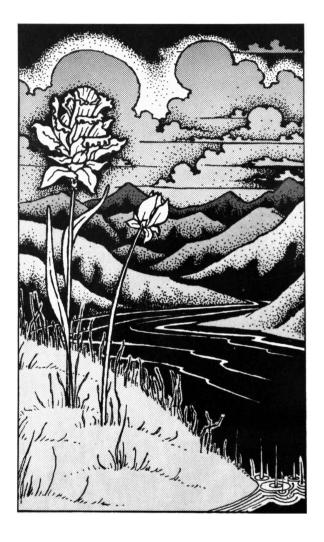


## Life is a river.

Who is experiencing all of this anyway?



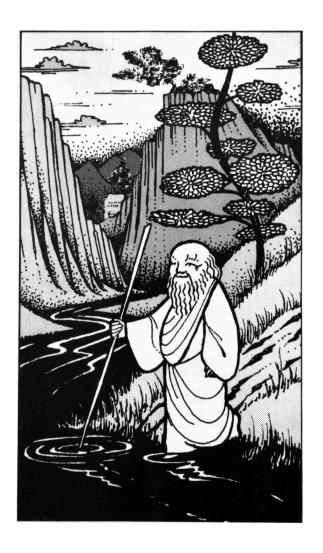
You are here next to me on the banks of The river.

Who am I that is speaking to you? No one in particular.

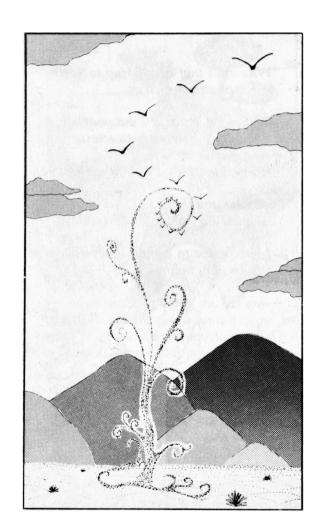
You might say that I am yourself. The only difference between us, As a matter of fact, Is that I am ahead of you in time.

Your life is the frame of your death;

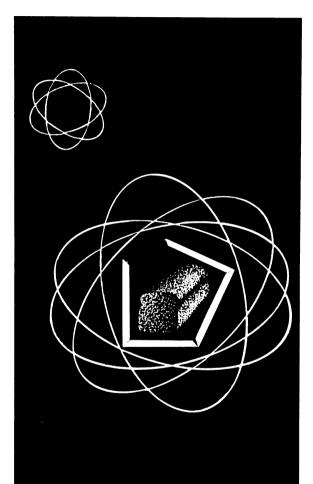
Nirvana is so big that it can't fit into any Frame.

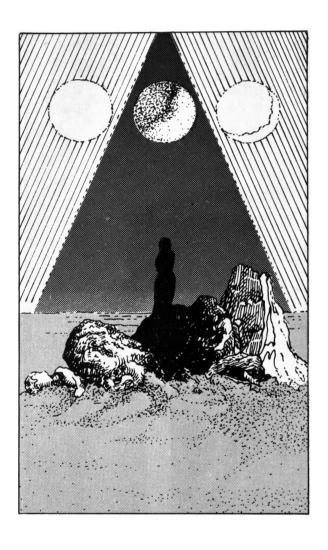
It is also too small.

Existence

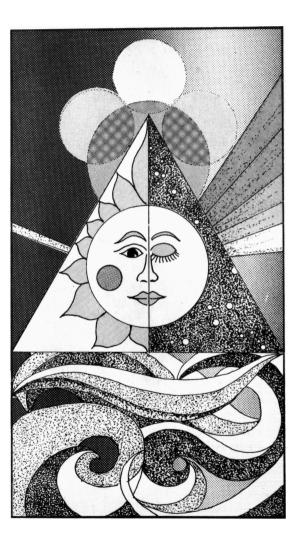




Since I am your future I can speak

We have always been and we will always be.

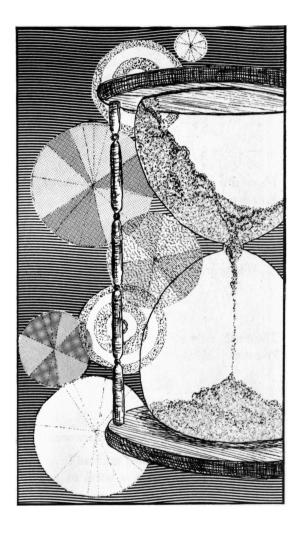
The two of us have always been sitting here on the banks of the River of Existence having this conversation.

It doesn't really exist, it is a convenient filing System that human beings have developed For segregating their experiences.



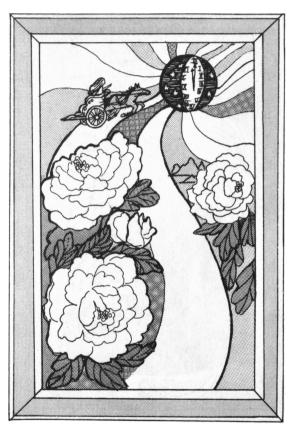
There are several ways to understand who You are.

They are known as the Four Paths.

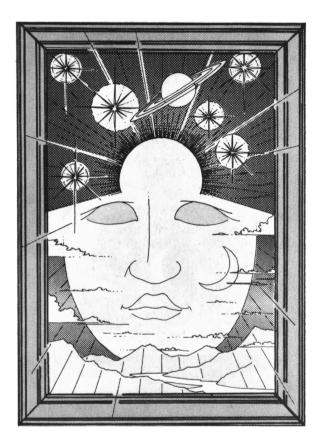
They are the four frames of the Windows of Existence.



The First Frame is Love. In Love you see Truth.



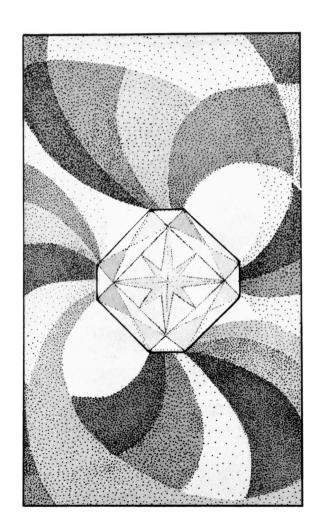
The Second Frame is Self Giving. In Self Giving you feel Truth.



The Third Frame is Discrimination. In Discrimination you become the Truth.



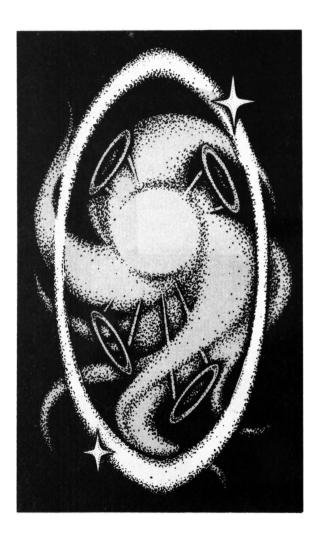
The Fourth Frame is Empty.

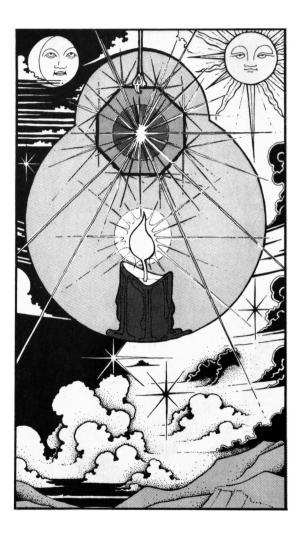
Perception is a prism.

It appears to be solid.



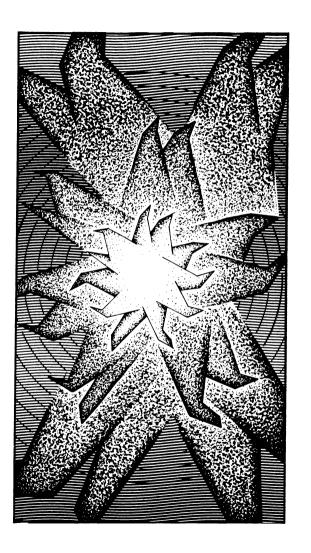
You can easily fathom the River of Existence, You only have to open yourself to Truth. This can be done by considering the Following thoughts:

Existence is formless. It has no definite Shape or color. The Prism of Perception Gives Existence the appearance of Form and color.

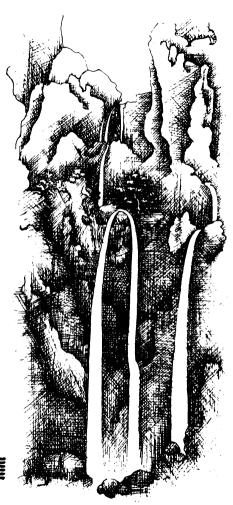


The appearance of life is the way you see The world.

At death—when the prism of your Perception breaks there will be nothing. Nothing meaning not anything in Particular.



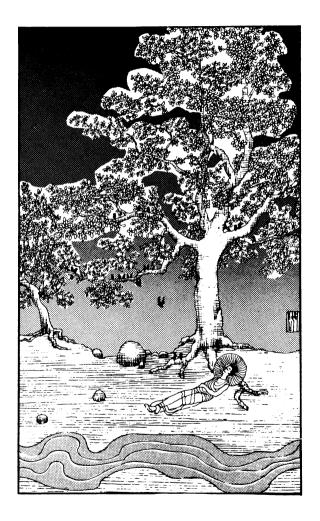

Let us look at the River of Life And learn.

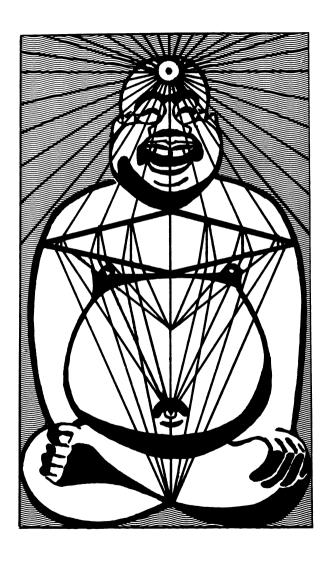
The River of Life flows by.

Meditation is the cessation of Thought.

When you stop your thoughts you Break the Prism of Perception.

In the interest of Time let me quickly Run this by you:



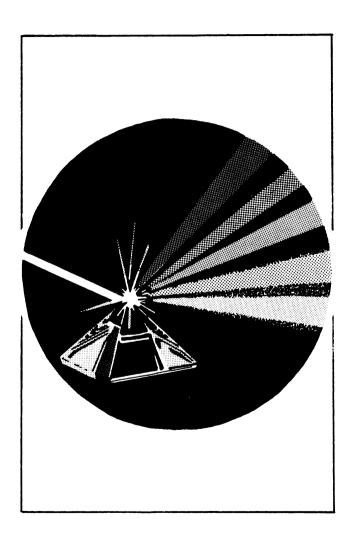
You are not your body. Your body is only an idea in your Mind.



You are not your mind. Your mind is only a feeling in your Conscious awareness.



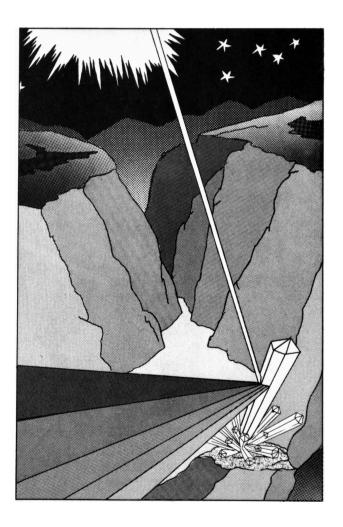
You are not your conscious awareness. Your conscious awareness is only a Fragment of God's Perception of Eternity.



## Remember the prism:

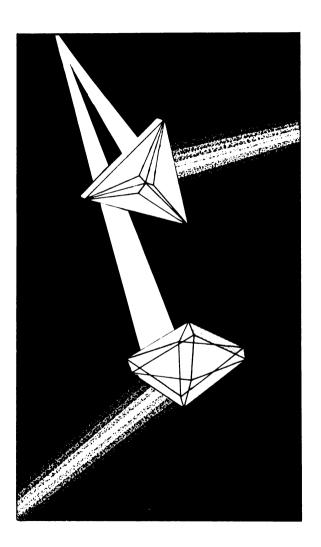
A shaft of White Light passes through It and is transformed into smaller Colored lights.

Your body, mind, perceptions, Memories, thoughts and feelings are all Colored shafts of Light that have been Refracted by the prism of your Perception.



If we trace these shafts of colored Light Back through the prism to their source Then we will find the White Light of Eternity.

What I am suggesting is that the Shaft Of White Light, the Prism of your Perception and the multi-colored hues Which you call your existence are all One.



If we stand back from a prism and Watch a ray of white light enter into It and then observe the multi-colored Hues emanating from it, We will see that there is no Separation:
There is only one Light, Unless we segregate it with our Perception.

But suppose the prism did something More to the Light than simply refract It?

Suppose the prism caused us to forget about the White Shaft of Light that is On the other side of the prism?

This is Maya. Maya means that We have forgotten our Source and True nature.

We have not only forgotten what we Once were.
We have forgotten what we are Right now.

Our Prism of Perception is the Prism of Illusion.





If we smash the prism what will happen?
The refracted bars of colored Light
Will vanish.

Then what will remain?
The original shaft of White Light.

The mistake most people make is to Suppose that the vision that they have Of this world is correct and complete. It is not.

It is at best a partial vision of Existence. God and Eternity are just beyond the Prism of your Perceptions.

Perception is the prism that causes you To forget.

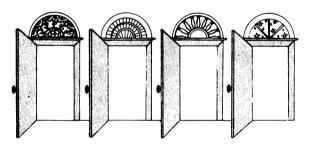
Life and Death are perceptions. Beyond them is Light. Hate and Fear are perceptions. Beyond them is Light.



You do not need to go beyond the Prism of your perceptions, you already Are. You need simply to become aware Of this.



Earlier I said that there are four
Frames through which we can
See Existence in its original formlessness.
Or it would be equally accurate to
Say that there are four doorways
Through which we can pass to reach
Eternity.



These doorways are Love, Self Giving, Discrimination and Mysticism.

These are the four primary colors of Spiritual Existence.

All Spiritual Paths are combinations and Recombinations of these four ways.



Love is the easiest of the four ways.

Love is a mirror in which we see God.

God is the Self – our Eternal being.

Whenever we love we go beyond time.

Love is the chariot of emotion which takes Us to our Beloved. When we love we see beyond the Prism of Illusion.

Love takes us through the Prism through Emotional oneness.
When we love we see our oneness with Others.



We — as one of the refracted lights — Love the other Refracted Lights. As we Love them, if we love truly and deeply, We see the White Light of Truth in Them. Seeing this reminds us that the Same Light exists within us too.

When we see that it is the same Light, The Prism disappears and we become The White Light of Eternity. As the Tibetans say: "Recognition is Liberation."



Self Giving works in a similar way. It changes our concept of our identity. We have forgotten that we are Eternity. We have the illusion of separativity.

This illusion is created by our ego. It is our ego that tells us we are a Separate body and mind caught up in Time. This is simply not true!

Our ego convinces us that we have an Existence that is separate from God's Existence.

Thus the illusion of birth and death Is created.

It is the illusion of separativity that Causes all of the pain and suffering in This world.

In deep meditation, when your mind Becomes silent, the Ego dissolves. When your ego dissolves the illusion of Separativity ends. You realize that you Are "one" with Everything.

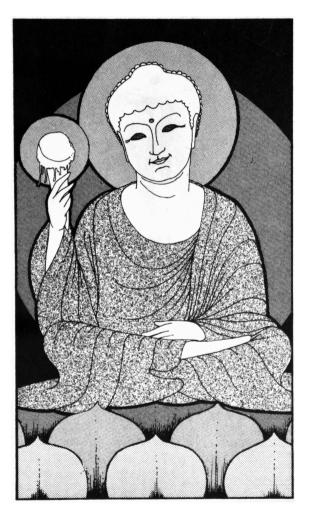
When we give to others
Our unselfishness removes the spot of
"Self" that stained our awareness.

Our ego, which separates us from our True identity, is gradually Worn away.

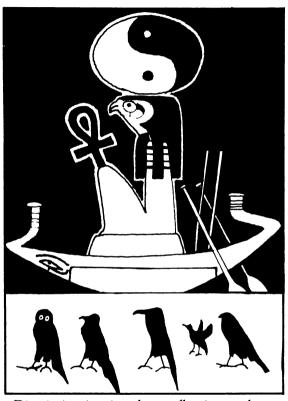
We perceive that God is in all of those We give to.

Then we see that the same God is Within ourselves.

Finally we see that there is no one and Nothing but God.

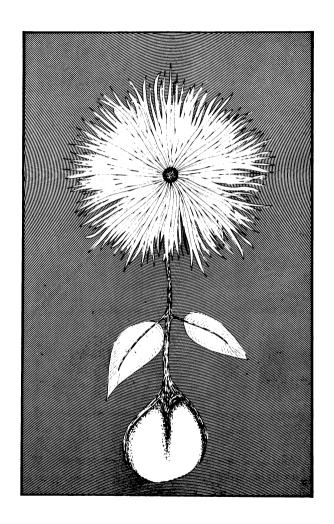


Discrimination and Mysticism are the two Remaining doorways.



Discrimination involves reflection and Absorption.

When you discriminate you examine all of The lights that the Prism of our Conscious Awareness has created.

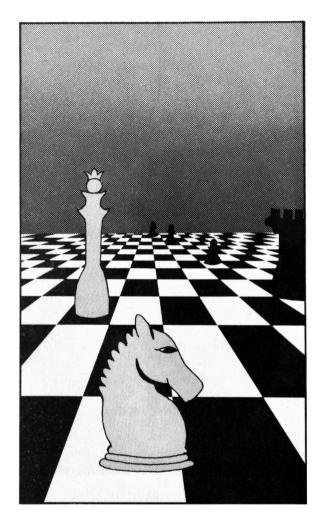


You look at them closely and ask Yourself if they are "real;" assuming that That which is really real will last forever. Naturally you see that they will not. When the Prism of Perception breaks They will vanish.

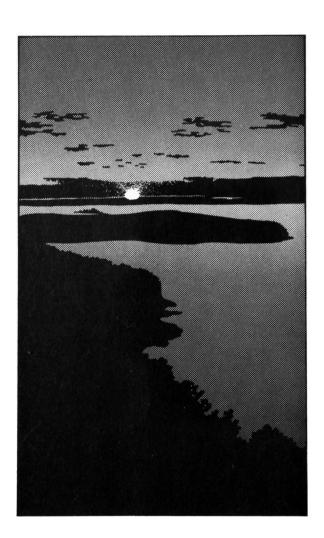
With this knowledge you
Dissolve them;
You place the Prism of Perception in
Your mind and gradually erase all of
The colors of perception until only
Two are left.

The two perceptions that are left are Your perception of yourself as a Perceiver And your perception of the Prism.

Smashing the Prism you dissolve Yourself. Two birds with one stone.



Mysticism is the hidden way.
It is the most difficult to discuss,
Because it involves the exploration of
Perceptual states which are difficult
To describe in words.



In Mysticism we deal with Dreaming and the Fields of Perception.

The idea is easy to understand.
All of life is a dream.
You are currently dreaming it.
You have dreamed everything that
You are and everything you are
Aware of.
You are asleep and have
Forgotten that you are
Dreaming.

You mistakenly Believe you are Awake. You have dreamed me into your dream To awaken you

From the Dreams of life, death and Separativity. You certainly do have strange dreams.

The way to awaken is as follows:

First you must realize that you are in a Dream.

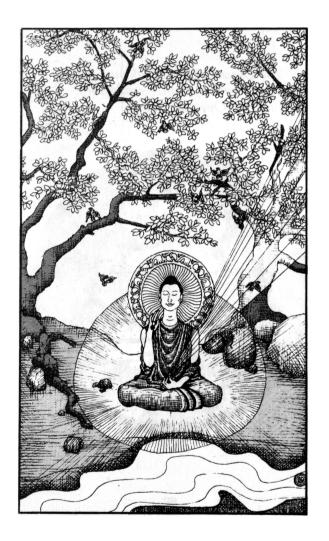
Then you must see that your current Dream is a Nightmare.

Next, you need to dream nicer dreams. I come from a world that is a Much nicer dream.



There are three primary dreams: They are the dreams of the Sleeping Self, The Awakening Self and The Awakened Self. The Dream of the Awakened Self is The Dream of the Opposite Self. I am the Opposite Self.





You were dreaming the dream of the Sleeping Self.
This is the dream of separativity.
The Sleeping Self is unaware of the Prism of Awareness.
It only sees the colored hues of the Transitory.

The Awakening Self is becoming aware That there is a deeper Self that lies on The other side of the Prism of Perception.

It cannot see what is on the other side Yet, but it accepts this idea. The Dream of the Awakened Self is the Perception of yourself as the White Light of Eternity, The Prism of Perception, and The multi-colored hues of existence.

This is salvikalpa samadhi. Nirvikalpa samadhi is smashing the prism. The entrance into Nirvana.



Naturally all of this is just a way of talking, A way of trying To express the inexpressible.

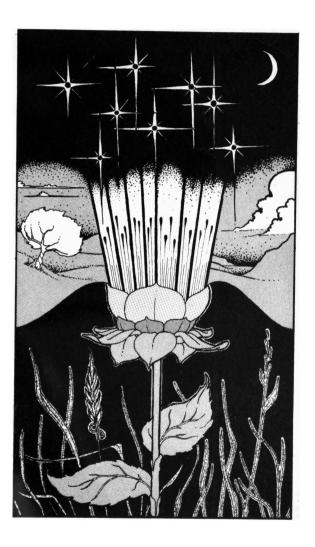
> Which brings us back to Dharma. Hopefully this will be easier for you To understand now.

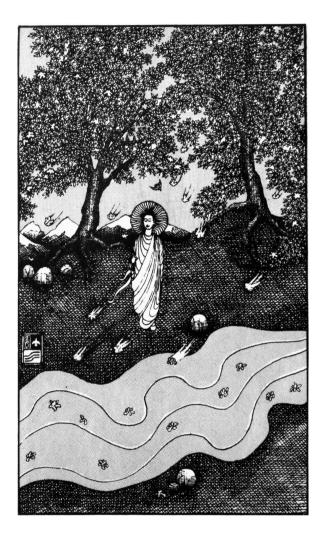
## Dharma is the essential Truth.

I your future,

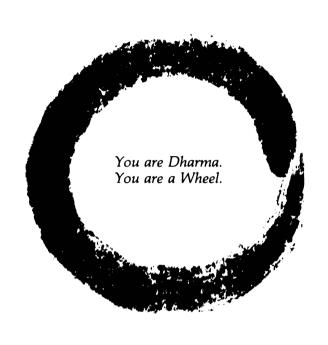
You, not my past.
